## **Logos Christian Academy Maai Mahiu Expansion**

Logos Christian academy Maai Mahiu is a unique Christian School within Naivasha sub - county. The school begun as a result of post-election violence in 2008 with the aim of catering to the needs of the displaced families within the then Jikaze IDP camp.

The school previously had five classrooms that were partitioned into two so as to accommodate twenty pupils per class. There was need to expand the school to cater for the needs of the community and its environs which include Maai Mahiu town and Longonot. God has been gracious and the school has constructed a new classroom block housing six additional spacious classrooms which can accommodate 35 pupils each. This will grow the pupils' enrolment from the current 200 to over three hundred and fifty.

The new block includes a dining hall which will serve as a church on Sundays, the administration offices, a kitchen with modern jikos (cookers), an ablution section that will ease congestion and a bus park. The greatest joy is that there is a canopy which is at the center of the school and it will be used for assembly, outdoor activities and other gatherings at the school.

The school leadership and church fraternity are eternally grateful to God for answering their prayer. And to Mariners and Willow-creek who funded this project. May the Lord enlarge your boundaries and may He bless you.


RE: BACK TO SCHOOL

The first day in particular was very interesting, because our school has been renovated and we have new classes. Learning is going to be more interesting.








## **Logos Christian School Nairobi on the move**
