WALKING THROUGH 2023

In 2023, the Logos Scholarship Fund achieved remarkable milestones that reflect our commitment to “*Educate for Life and Eternity*” through the **SPARC** framework. With your unwavering support, we celebrated the fulfillment of 76 scholarships. Among them, 34 were awarded to new Form 1 scholars, while the remaining 42 continued to support our existing scholars.

EMPOWERING THE NEXTGEN THROUGH ACADEMIC CLINICS:

In January, we introduced the “*Academic Clinic*,” a platform designed to help students gauge their progress, foster accountability, and provide a space for voicing challenges in their academic pursuits. 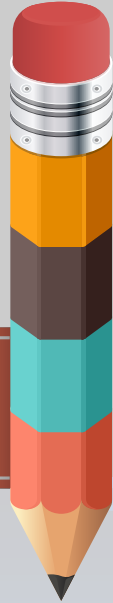


2024 TARGETS
