

However, my parents still had financial challenges and it was proving difficult once again to go to high school. By God's favour I got to know of the Logos Scholarship Program. I got the high school sponsorship and an added bonus of a mentor, who has been with me for the four—year journey and kept encouraging me in challenging times.

### ANDREASGEMEINDE CHURCH

Nairobi Chapel and Andreasgemeinde Niederhöchstadt has nurtured a friendship of more than 10 years. Andreasgemeinde, a church community situated close to the city of Frankfurt and belonging to the Lutheran church in Germany wanted to broaden its understanding on how the message of Jesus Christ is spread and heard in the rest of the world. So, it started looking for a church community outside of Germany to partner with.



In 2012 Bishop Oscar Muriu visited Andreasgemeinde in Niederhöchstadt and from that time on our partnership started to grow. During a visit in 2014 Bishop Oscar introduced Andreasgemeinde to the Logos program and motivated our church to join in the program on the understanding that a sponsor in Nairobi Chapel and a sponsor in Andreasgemeinde would mutually support the school fees for a child in Kenya.

What most convinced the members of Andreasgemeinde was the fact that Nairobi Chapel would support the students not only financially but also through mentorship and personal guidance. So, we are now entering the 10th year of this fruitful partnership between Nairobi Chapel and Andreasgemeinde. In this time 171 students have been supported by Andreasgemeinde.

During these years' members of Andreasgemeinde were able to visit Nairobi Chapel and meet Logos pupil which was very helpful to get a better understanding for the importance of the Logos program.

Andreasgemeinde is grateful for this partnership and is looking forward to its continuation.

Since then, we have also been able to sponsor 25 Logos Scholars through High School through our guest referral program. Through this, we donate 50 USD to the Logos Scholarship Fund every time one of our guests refers a friend or family member to our company. We have chosen Logos as beneficiary of this program due to our long standing relationship and the trust we have built.
